School Uniform Adjustments (Summer Term 2022)

Dear Parent or Carer,

Now that we are moving into the final half term of the year, I am writing to inform you that there is some relaxation and adjustment of our school uniform rules for the remainder of this summer term. From Monday 6th June, on our return to school, the following is what we expect to be worn from all students in Years 7 to 10 ('Option A' or 'Option B').

Option 'A' – School Uniform

White shirt (short or long sleeved)

School tie

Trousers (Black) – No denim

Black socks

Footwear – Plain black

Coat – Waterproof (*no hoodies / no zippers*)

Optional items: School blazer, school jumper (plain black with the school badge)

Option 'B' – PE / Games Kit

Green or red St. Joseph's Polo Shirt

Green or red St. Joseph's Shorts/Skorts and/or unisex plain black joggers / leggings

Socks / trainers

Coat – Waterproof (*no hoodies / no zippers*)

If pupils do not have the correct St. Joseph's PE kit, then they must wear their usual school uniform (Option 'A').

Pupils are not expected to wear blazers to school from June 6th and will remain as an optional item up until the end of the Summer Term only.

Coats are no longer to be worn in classrooms during lessons.

There is to be no "mix and match" combining uniform items (Option 'A') with PE kit (Option 'B') and vice versa.

Hoodies, zippers and denim of any description are not permitted in school. Please also note that facial piercings are not allowed either, and that hair colour should at all times be natural.
