Rome Pilgrimage (September 2024)

36 pupils (Year 10 to Year 13) and 4 members of staff undertook a pilgrimage to Rome. Their trip was packed with activities. They first visited the Catacombs of San Sebastian and the basilica of the same name. The next couple of days they visited the Colosseum, the Pantheon, the Spanish Steps, the Trevi Fountain and the Piazza Navona. The penultimate day was given over to visit the heart of the Catholic Church, including a tour of the Vatican Museums and St Peter's Basilica. On the final day they visited the Museum and Crypt of the Capuchin Friars. Both pupils and staff described the experience as 'absolutely amazing'. We thank Mr Jones, Mrs Lyddon, Miss Thomas and Mr McWilliams for accompanying the pupils to Rome. In 2024 a total of 48 pupils and 8 members of staff (3 from the RE Department) have had the opportunity to go on a pilgrimage to Rome (March and September trips).
